



Charnwood Borough Council has organised the planting of 14,480 trees on two former arable fields in Hathern. The trees will be in separate blocks to reflect different soil conditions.

Trees will be planted to be planted in rows with enough space to allow mechanical access for maintenance, and these rows will be curved where possible. The tree tubes will be 1.2m tall, which should be high enough to prevent browsing by deer.

Going forward, the tree understorey will be mown when required and the centre of the grass paths will be mown regularly. Trees will be weeded twice a year (in April and June) for 5 years. The litter/dog bin will be emptied weekly.
