Located within the centre of the UK, Charnwood is exceptionally well connected.

Junction 23 of the MI gives direct access to Loughborough and Shepshed. This means Charnwood is quickly linked in to the national motorway network. The A46 trunk road provides a link from the MI across to the AI and easy access within minutes to Leicester.


East Midlands Airport is on our doorstep linking Charnwood to over 80 UK and international destinations. Its air freight operations are now the second largest in the UK putting local businesses within touching distance of the worldwide supply chain.

Birmingham International Airport is less than one hour's drive away. This gives access to more than 260 destinations, including New York, Delhi and several European business capitals.

Our rail links are superb. Be in the centre of Leicester in less than 10 minutes or Nottingham in 15 minutes or Derby in just over 20 minutes. For those business meetings in London, the train whisks you to St. Pancras station in just under 1 hr 15 minutes.

Many businesses now rely on digital technology and communication – our superfast broadband connectivity is very good with coverage for businesses estimated to be 95% in 2016 and expected to be 96% in 2018. Further roll-out of superfast access is due from 2018 onwards.

Charnwood is also an active partner in Midlands Connect, an initiative which will improve consistent transport connectivity across Leicestershire and the wider Midlands Engine area.







Innovative business is a characteristic of Charnwood. There are networks — such as LATI (Leading Advanced Technology and Innovation) - which encourage and enable businesses to continually grow and innovate.

Of particular value to many businesses is the presence of Loughborough University. The University is ranked overall as one of the top six in the UK and is in first place in many surveys regarding student experience and quality of education.

The University is a key partner for many businesses, engaging in joint research and development projects. Many businesses are born out of knowledge emanating from the University and high calibre graduates provide an excellent

pool of labour for your workforce. Many companies are now choosing the University's Science and Enterprise Park as their first choice for premises due to the ability to be at the heart of a cluster of innovation and world-class support services.

Charnwood's Loughborough College has an excellent track record in providing apprenticeships and vocational training.

Charnwood has a rich variety of businesses of different sizes and many of these are spread across our 58 employment areas.

There is a good stock of premises of different types available. Whether you are looking for small serviced office accommodation or large premises for manufacturing Charnwood can accommodate most needs.

In 2017, a new Enterprise Zone was created. The Loughborough and Leicester Science and Innovation Enterprise Zone will prove particularly attractive to businesses looking to take advantage of the Zone's package of incentives, including relief from business rates for five years and access to superfast broadband.





The Enterprise Zone captures two sites in Charnwood. Loughborough University Science and Enterprise Park will provide a home for advanced engineering and manufacturing alongside energy and low carbon industries. Charnwood Campus provides specialist pharmaceutical laboratory accommodation and office facilities.

Charnwood Campus has also been recognised by the Government as the country's first and only Life Sciences Opportunity Zone.

Excellent opportunities exist for new commercial development at Charnwood's varied mix of regeneration sites and on land allocated for new employment development. Some sites are available for occupation now, others will be available in the medium to longer term. Business centre facilities are offered by the Borough


Various regeneration sites of different sizes in Loughborough town centre, Loughborough's Heritage Quarter, Dishley Grange and Shepshed town centre.


Labour costs in Charnwood are competitive and are lower than the UK average.


