- 4. Your case officer may make unannounced visits based on the times and days that you say the nuisance usually occurs.
- 5. You must sign and date the form below and return it to your case officer at the Council offices.
- 6. If you need a copy of this diary sheet, please make a copy yourself, as we may not retain the sheet that you submit to us.
