



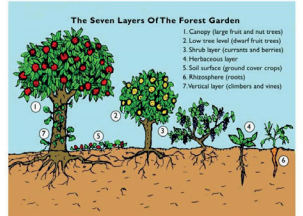

Grow Give Live's vision is to create a community space in Syston where sustainability, community and well being are at the heart of everything we do. Through the shared goal of 'growing our own', we aim to encourage the community to get involved with the outdoors, learn about sustainable growing and living and discover how this can improve our mental and physical well being.

- KEY & NOTATION**
- A Access and area for off loading or sales.
 - B Permissive access created across site
 - C 3m wide gated secure access
 - D Wheelchair and special needs raised beds
 - E No-Dig Beds
 - F Wildlife pond to attract frogs to control pests
 - G Bee Hive area, underplanted with wildflowers and incorporating fruit trees.
 - H Post & Rail Fence with native hedgerow to create secure boundary.
 - I Existing hedge layed and tree canopies raised to allow visual supervision whilst creating dense boundary
 - J Forest Garden, consisting of fruit/nut trees, fruit bush understorey and edible ground flora. Area to only contain things that are safe for horses.
 - K Meadow area for horse grazing and foraging, encourage brambles, elderberries etc to hedgerows
 - L Woodcraft area
 - M Woodland/Miyawaki forest creation area
 - N 3 Sided Shelter & Picnic Benches to create gathering place & nurture the sense of community on the site
