The current contract expires on the 31st October 2024, in order to provide service continuation from this point the Council needs to sign the contract to provide the contractor with enough time to initial, test and implement the new systems in time for the required go live of 14th October 2024.

The decision needs to be taken urgently and within timescales which do not allow for the usual required number of days for advance notification of a Key Decision.
